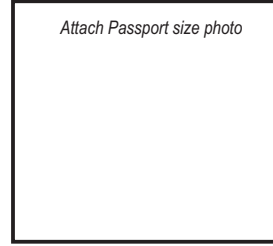

- ✓ Vegetarian, 3 in a room.
- ✓ Outstation students will be accommodated for the summer camp and provided boarding , lodging and internal transport during their 60 day stay in Bangalore.
- ✓ Those found talented based on performance will be given free education , academics and cricket training and will also be recommended to the National Cricket Academy in Bangalore .
- ✓ Those interested are to report on 1st April at 8 am to St Johns medical college ground, Koramangla, (opp St Johns medical hospital, koramangla) and will be directed to the lodge close to the ground.
- ✓ Application form can be downloaded here. the form has to be duly filled and sent back to our mailing address, before reaching Bangalore with cash/DD in favour of "Imtiaz Ahmed Cricket Academy" payable at Bangalore.
- ✓ Trainees must wear official cricket clothes. i.e. white pant and a IACA white shirt for matches and a custom made IACA track suit for practice. The official cap is compulsory. This uniform is available at **our store**. (to be purchased seperatly on arrival)
- ✓ IACA is not responsible for any injury or loss of life sustained by a trainee on the field of play
- ✓ IACA is not responsible for loss of kit of the trainees
- ✓ Discipline and decorum has to be maintained while inside the campus.
- ✓ Identity cards will be made for trainees of St Johns Medical College ground. **3 photographs** have to be submitted for this purpose.

Summer camp instructions: (all of the above and:-)

- ✓ Training will begin from 1st April 2010 and end on 18th May 2010.. After 7 weeks , from May 20th – 30th , the 25th All India Pepsi Cup will be conducted. Boys above 6 years may attend the 60 day camp.
- ✓ Initially boys will be divided in different age groups, i.e. Under 10, Under 12, Under 14, Under 16 and seniors. After 1 week students will be regrouped according to their talent.
- ✓ Selections will be made on 18th May to form teams for the All India Pepsi Cup at 7 am. The entire academy will assemble to make these teams.
- ✓ Outstation boys will be required to stay in Bangalore for 60 days from April 1st to may 30th .
- ✓ Payment of fees mentioned above are for the entire duration and will include the cricket coaching fee.
- ✓ Fees once paid is neither transferrable nor refundable under any circumstances.
- ✓ Boys below 13 years should be accompanied by a senior cricketer/ guardian to ensure his security.
- ✓ Groups of more than 5 trainees can avail a special 10 % discount.
- ✓ Outstation boys are required to attend all 3 sessions a day, with Mondays being a rest day.
- ✓ A warden will be appointed to stay with the boys to take care of them
- ✓ IACA is not responsible for the security of the boys if they leave the lodge without written permission.
- ✓ Trainees leaving the lodge outside the group to visit families/ shopping etc will do so with prior written permission.
- ✓ IACA is not responsible for valuables lost during the stay.
